Message from our EGMHA President

Welcome back to all returning families, and welcome to those that are new to EGMHA. In case you blinked and missed "summer", it is indeed coming to an end, and the hockey season is ramping up.

This should be another great year with changes big and small. Later in this newsletter you will read about the new half-ice/cross-ice program that we are pleased to roll out as part of our development focus on the younger ages. We are also in discussion with the skating club regarding a pilot to put a strong focus on skating skills - particularly at the younger ages.

We are supporting the OMHA inclusiveness efforts in rolling out Gender Identification and Expression education to all coach staff.

We have commissioned construction of a new trophy case to highlight our successes and give special attention to our Dunsmuir tournament trophies.

The Minor Bantam and Minor Midget rep teams will be rostered as MD (Minor Development). Minor Development programs are receiving a lot of attention throughout York Simcoe as they offer a representative level of competitiveness, but without the body checking. It is felt that this will help make competitive hockey attractive to a larger audience and keep kids playing longer.

Other changes that you can look forward to include new snackbar ownership. We have reached out to the town to extend our desire for an improvement in healthy food alternatives with this new vendor.

A custom fit mouth guard is fabricated while you wait (usually within 1-3 hours, Once it is completed the fit is checked and adjustments are made on the spot.



Mouth Guards must be picked up same day. A protective case is included in the cost (which is generally around \$50).
