





Representative Program

- EGMHA had 2 MD teams in YSMHL league this year
 - U8MD numbers were low, were able to supplement with some players from GMHA
- U10 and up participated in the Upper York Admirals Year 1 pilot
- Several Upper York teams saw success early with tournament wins
- Upper York had one team: U15 AA win YSMHL Championships
- Three teams qualified for the OMHA Championships: U10AA, U14 BB, U15 AA
 - U15AA were semifinalists in the OMHA Championships
- Tryouts are nearly complete for next season (except for U18)
- Working on the constitution, targeting a Fall vote on whether to finalize the pilot to a
 permanent merger with GMHA

Tournaments

Friendship Jamboree

- U8MD teams participated in the tournament which raised \$2,960
- Ran smoothly, no challenges reported

Total \$18,955

Winter Classic

- 53 Teams participated
- U9 MD, U11 to U18 HL/LL participated in the tournament which raised \$7,215
- Timing coinciding with high school final exams, issues with finding timekeepers during day Friday

- Total of 57 teams, U10 A to U18 A, also including U13 AA division participated in the tournament which raised \$8,780
- Timing coinciding with Super Bowl Sunday needed to ensure wrapped up earlier on Sunday

Constitution and By-Laws Proposal



- Ontario Not-For-Profit Corporation Act (ONCA) came into force on October 19, 2021 replacing the Ontario Corporation Act. ONCA provides a modern legislative framework for the governance of Ontario's not-for-profit corporations and charities.
- A 3-year transition period was granted during which organizations would bring their constating documents (i.e. By-Laws, letters patent and supplementary letters patent in "Articles of Amendment", etc.) into conformity with the new ONCA.
- The links have been posted on the EGMHA website for the required two weeks prior to the AGM

Constitution and By-Laws Proposal



- If the ONCA proposal is not approved, will need to adjust and hold another meeting prior to the legislated transition date
- Package#1 was submitted for consideration, will review first and any amendments from this package that are passed will be incorporated as amendments to the proposed changes in ONCA package

What to Expect next season



- September evaluations for U8/U9 MD, U7/U8/U9 Select and U18 AA,A,B/BB
- New House League U7 and below Development program
- New Competitive Player Pathway Select program U7 to U9
- First Shift in late Fall/early Winter
- More community participation
 - Ball Hockey Tournament at Mount Albert Sports Day
 - Family Day Skating Sponsor (TBC)
- Proposed Tournaments
 - Friendship Jamboree (U8 MD teams)
 - Winter Classic (U9MD, U9-U18 HL/LL teams)
 - Dunsmuir Memorial Tournament (U10-U18 A teams)
 - Spring Fling (U10-U16 A/B/BB teams)

NHL/NHLPA First Shift Program

- The NHL/NHLPA Program introduces hockey for families in an affordable and manageable (time commitment) way that is safe and fun!
- Program fee includes:
 - BAUER Equipment (Head-to-Toe)
 - Welcome Event
 - Equipment fitting demonstration
 - 6 Weeks, 1 session/week
 - Insurance for participants
- Hockey Canada Curriculum:
 - Small areas games
 - Skating skills, puck handling, passing and shooting exercises





Competitive Player Pathway (CPP)





CPP Select is designed in accordance with the Hockey Canada Pathway and Ontario Hockey Federation (OHF) Player Development Model

- CPP Select is an extension of House League and open to all players on an evaluation basis. Teams will have 1 extra hour of ice weekly.
- CPP Teams will play in one of two Divisions CPP North and CPP South.
- Each Team will play approximately 18 regular season games at a rate of 3 games per month in a balanced schedule rotating among the different Member Associations within their Division.
- Games can start as early as October.
- Teams may also participate in tournaments and exhibition games outside of the CPP program.
- End of Season Jamboree

What to Expect next season

- Regular season programming should begin mid to late September
- New draft selection for all House League and Local League teams
- U9 to U13 will be moving to an interlocked House League with GMHA (perhaps other centres as well)
- Surveyed U15 to U18 now to determine if HL or LL is the preference
 - LL was the overwhelming preference in these age groups
- New Apparel Vendor Storefront in Bradford (see following slide)
 - $_{\circ}$ $\,$ Will be focusing on increased Eagles branding in the rink and community
- New sponsorship partnership Kidspired
- Moving into our second year of our two-year pilot with Georgina Minor Hockey to develop the Upper York Admirals
 - Will keep working towards completing the requirements to bring the Upper York Admirals pilot project to a permanent amalgamation membership vote in Fall 2024.




